F.A.Q

What is Padel Tennis?

Padel is a racket sport that combines the best of tennis and squash and it includes the walls. Padel is has the same as tennis and there is NO need to have a tennis background.

How many players are required?

Padel tennis is ideally played as doubles / in teams of two - 4 players per game, however 2 players can play.

What clothing should I wear?

Players must wear appropriate footwear. Tennis shoes or sports footwear are mandatory on the Padel court. Active wear is advised.

How do I use my Padel Tennis Racket?

Slip the strap of the racket over your wrist and keep it strapped on at all times during play.

What is the cost to play Padel Tennis?

Exclusive Resident/Health Club Member rates available. Padel Court rental is for 60 mins and includes equipment. A £20 deposit is required for all bookings.

All Padel Tennis equipment must be returned to Killyhevlin Health Club when you have completed your game.

Is Padel Tennis easy to play?

Padel offers a great physical activity which is fun and social! A great sport for all ages and skills, it is quick and easy to learn, and highly addictive. Ideal for families, groups, friends, seniors and kids.

How do you score?

The scoring system in Padel tennis is the same as in regular tennis. Six games must be won to win a set, and the team that gets two sets wins the game.

How do you serve?

“The serve”, the following rules apply:

All play begins with an underarm serve from the right service court into the opponent's court diagonally across similar to tennis.

The server must allow the ball to bounce once before hitting it and the ball must be hit below waist level, as in tennis, you get a second serve.

Where is the Padel Tennis Court?

Our Padel Tennis court is located on the grounds of the hotel beside ‘Killy Kids’ Play Park.

Who invented Padel?

Mexican businessman Enrique Corcuera set up the first-ever Padel court at his holiday home in Acapulco in 1969 – but the roots of the sport go back further than that.

Introduced to the UK in 1992, Padel has been played for more than 100 years and has become a sporting phenomenon.
